Since its founding by farmworker advocates in a room above La Luna Market in Rutherford, OLE Health has been guided by one core principle: everyone deserves quality healthcare as a basic human right. Over the past five decades, OLE Health has made dramatic advances in the way in which it delivers healthcare services to those most vulnerable and those most likely to otherwise not have access to care. **Today, more than 40,000 residents of Napa and Solano Counties call OLE Health their medical home.**

- OLE Health is the **largest** provider of bilingual outpatient services in Napa County.
- **3 out of 4** of OLE Health's patients live at or below 200% of the federal poverty level.
- **Over 4,000** farmworkers and/or their family members receive care from OLE Health.
- OLE Health is the **only** healthcare provider in Napa County accepting new Medi-Cal pediatric patients and Denti-Cal.
- In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, OLE Health addressed food insecurity for 10,000 families, and by the end of September will have administered more than **40,000** vaccines.



OLE Health Services

Adult Health — Same-day acute care visits, cancer screenings, immunizations, diabetes screening, chronic pain management, integrated behavioral health and nutrition support

Women's Health — Prenatal care, perinatal services, family planning, primary care, outpatient gynecology, pregnancy testing

Pediatric Health — Same-day acute care visits, well-child exams, sports physicals, hospital care for newborns at Queen of the Valley

Dental Health — X-rays, exams, cleanings, fluoride treatments, fillings, sealants, emergency care

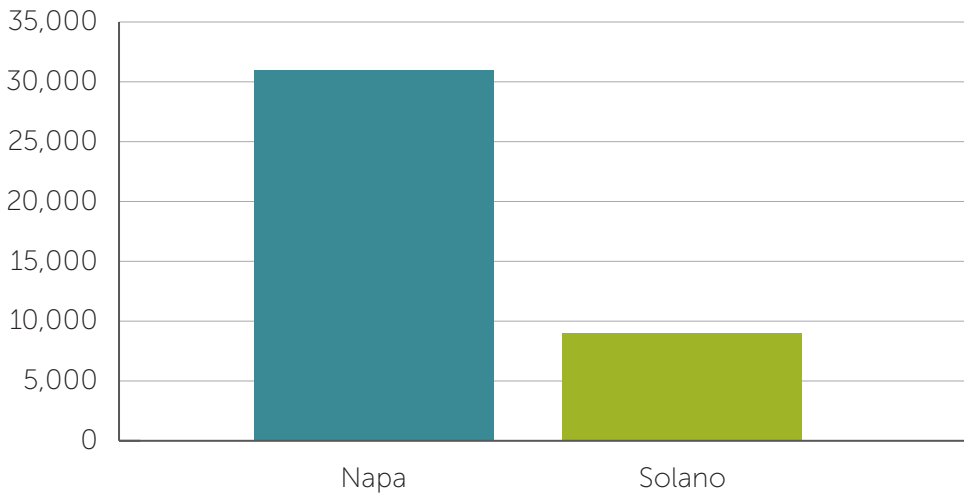

Patient Demographics

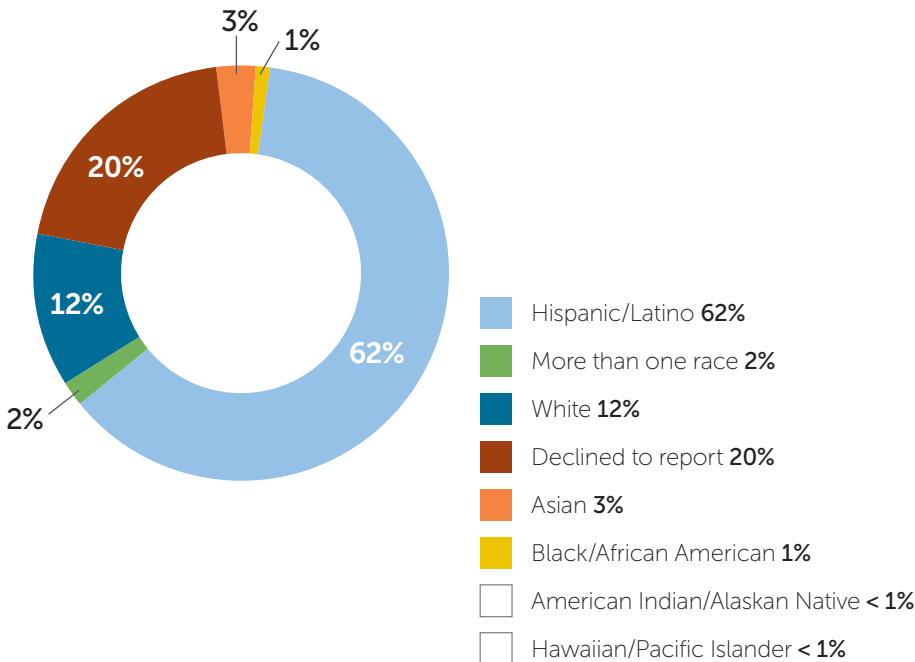
Of the total population of patients OLE Health serves across all sites, **77% are at or below 200%** of the federal poverty level.

Roughly 4,000, or 10% of OLE Health patients are farmworkers.
